Mergon Connect

Mergon Connect is a gathering for their funding partners. Mergon funds part of our Heroes for Hope programme in Langa. It was hearwarming to meet the full team behind the work of Mergon, to be more aware of their aspirations for our success, and to be uplifted by the encouraging stories of other NGOs doing excellent work. Megon makes funding partners feel like they are part of the family. The two-day event had a relaxed schedule with rich input, stirring worship, lots of laughs, and plenty of time for networking.

Sowers Trust

Sowers Trust is another faithful funding partner of SU Western Cape. Of particular encouragement was the intentional time given to hearing the stories of other NGOs in attendance. J-Life - SA Summit

At the beginning of October I had the privilege of attending the J-Life Africa Summit. The weekend was attended by leaders from South Africa, Eswatini, and Lesotho who are committed to building disciple-making movements. Although most Christians would agree that we are called to make disciples, I was once again struck by how intentional we need to be if we are going to fulfill Jesus' commission in Matthew 28. I was encouraged to pursue SU's mission with even greater determination: Leading young people to know and walk with God.

Youth Leaders Training 2024
